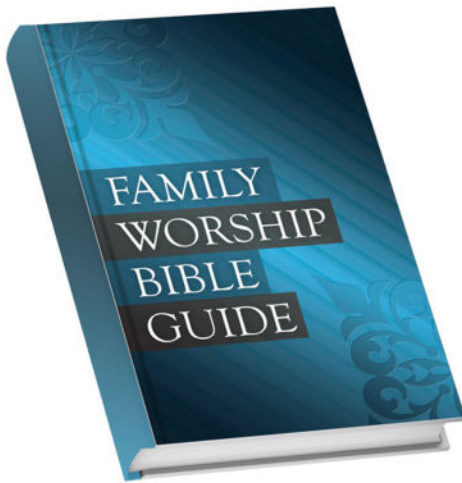

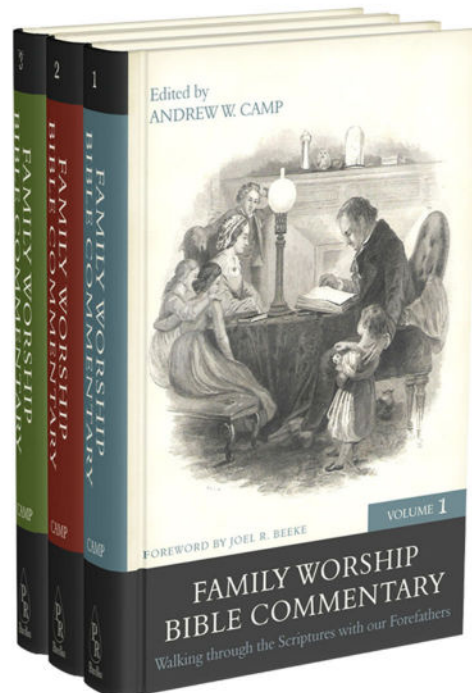
Family Worship Bible Guide

Family Worship Bible Commentary 3 Volume

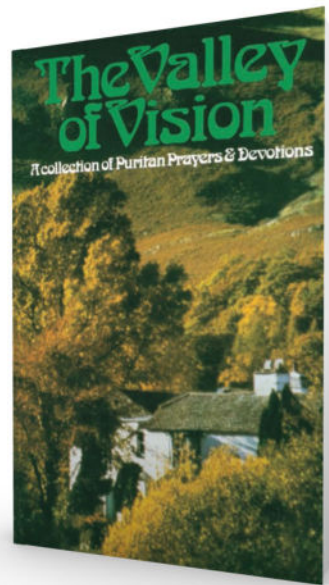
